Online Magazine Options

You may create an online magazine instead of a paper magazine. I recommend <u>Adobe Spark</u> or <u>Google Sites</u>; if you know of another site you could use, let me know. Neither of these will work on your iPad, so if you choose to do an online magazine, you need to be able to work on a computer or laptop at home, and/or work in my room at lunch. You will turn in your magazine by pasting the link into a form on the due date.

NOTE: Do NOT just insert or upload your essays as documents. An online magazine wouldn't look like that. Each page of your site should have a large title, plus large pictures that break up all the essay text. Layout for this magazine should look different from a paper version. It might work best to insert one paragraph at a time so you can have pictures between them.

Google Sites:

- In Google Drive, click: New > More > Google Sites
- add pages to your site and title them appropriately
- your "home" page should be like the front cover of a magazine (see packet for front cover requirements)
- somewhere on the home page you need a table of contents
- each essay needs its own page
- your ads may be on the same pages as the essays, or you may put the ads on their own page(s); ads should be large
- The domain (address) for your new site is the title of your magazine + 2019.
- It's up to you how to put it all together; you just need to get all the required pieces on the pages of the site.

Adobe Spark: your magazine will be one long web page.

- Front cover is at the top
- Directly below your front page, insert text for your name, class period, etc.
- Table of contents would go next, and can have an ad next to it
- Essays can fill the screen (with pictures in between some of the paragraphs)
- Copy / paste your essay into Adobe Spark and it should give you space between paragraphs to add pictures.
- Or you can have an essay on ½ of the screen and an ad on the other ½
- It's up to you how to put it all together; you just need to get all the required pieces on the web page.
